3 Months – 1 Year	Blue Beginners A gentle, loving introduction to daycare and early routine for babies and toddlers.
1-2 Years	Dream Discoverers Encouraging curiosity, confidence, language, and early social interaction through play.
2-3 Years	Emerald Explorers Active learning, imagination, creativity, and hands-on discovery for growing young minds.
3-4 Years	Golden Growers Developing independence, communication, structure, and school readiness.
Grade RR (4-5 Years)	Red Readers Preparing children confidently for Grade R and formal learning foundations.

Meals & Nutrition

Children aged 2 years and older receive:

Children younger than 2 years are required to bring their own meals and bottles depending on developmental needs.

Parents must notify the school of:

- allergies,
- dietary requirements,
- intolerances,
- medical concerns.

Holiday Care

Holiday care is available for enrolled learners during school holidays unless otherwise communicated.

Safety & Security

The safety and well-being of every child remain a priority.

Security procedures may include:

- controlled access,
- authorised collections,
- visitor monitoring,
- supervision procedures.

Parents are requested to cooperate fully with all safety measures.
